Clause 4 of the Original Trust Deed shall be substituted by the following clause

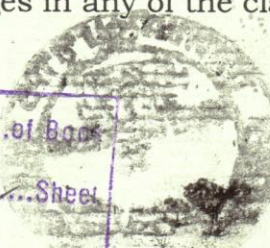
Constitution of the Board of Trustees

- a) The Board of Trustees shall consist of not less than three persons and not more than nine persons
- b) At present the Board of Trustees shall consist of the following persons

- c) **Mr. NELSON VARGHESE** shall be the Managing Trustee for life
- d) All the trustees as and when appointed shall hold office for life
- e) In case of any vacancy arising on account of death, retirement and resignation or otherwise, the surviving or remaining trustee or trustees as the case may be shall have full powers to constitute and represent the board of trustees for the time being
- f) On the death of the founder the Managing Trustee at that point of time or if the founder was the Managing Trustee, his successor in office shall be considered to be the founder of the trust, who shall be eligible to present and register any supplementary deed of trust to bring into effect any changes in any of the clause of the trust

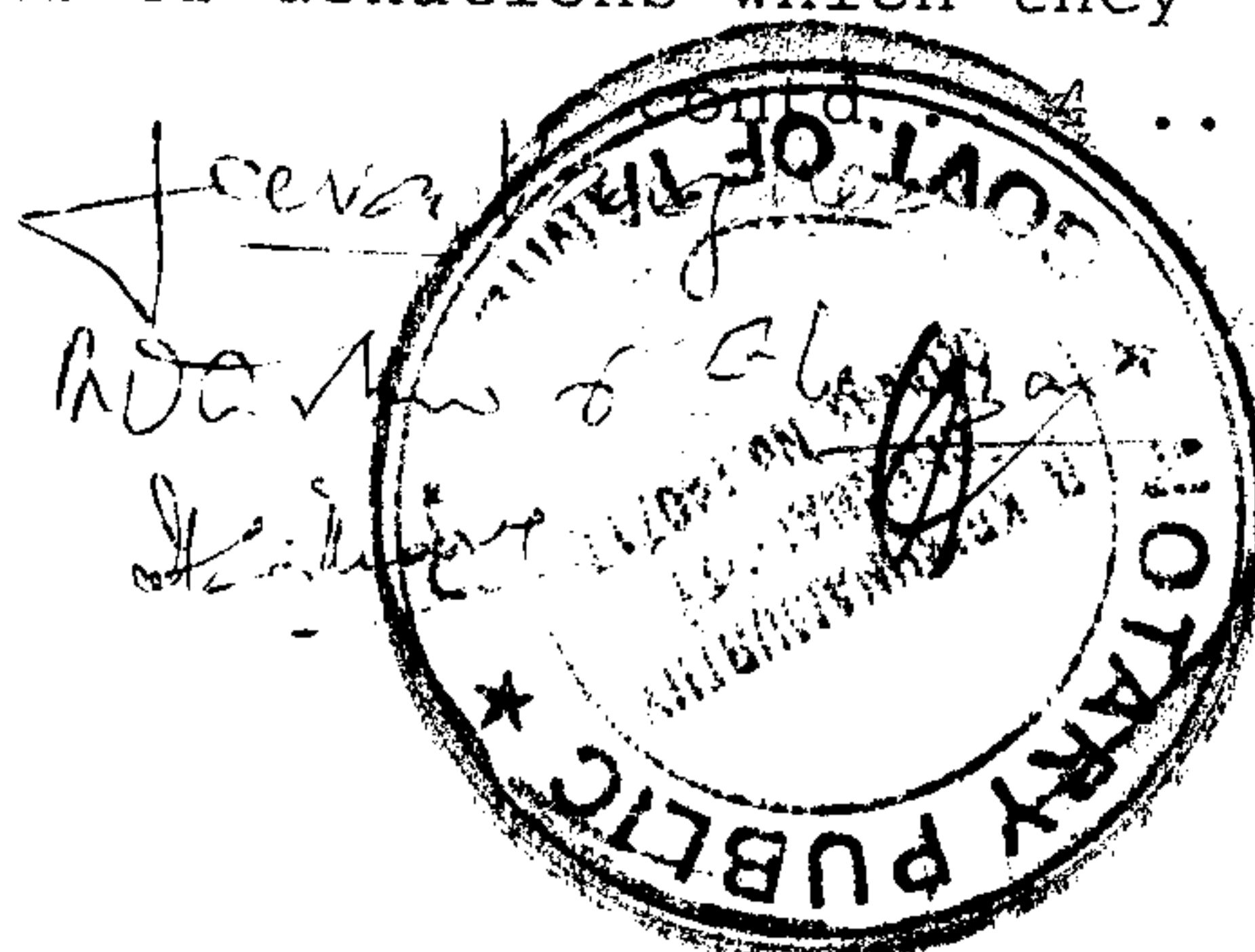
2. OBJECTS OF THE TRUST :

- (1) To utilise the income as well as the principal of the said Trust fund for charitable purposes, i.e.: relief of the poor, education and medical relief without distinction of caste or creed and to, particularly, carryout programme of rural development, Viz., promotion of social and economic welfare and the upliftment of the public in any rural area, including
 - (i) To provide assistance in setting up rural centres in selected areas for the the rural population to provide them self-employment.
 - (ii) a. Establishment and
b. running of rural dispensaries, maternity, child welfare and family centres, and homes for the aged.
 - (iii) Nutrition programme for school children.
 - (iv) a. establishment and
b. running of educational, medical and vocational training centres, and institutions for retarded and disabled people.
 - (v) a. Construction and
b. maintenance of drinking water projects such wells, tube wells etc.
 - (vi) a. Construction and
b. maintenance of rural link roads, village streets pavements and drainage.
 - (vii) Assistance to weaker sections by constructing houses on sites provided in rural areas by the Trust, Government, village, Panchayat etc.
 - (viii) Supply of improved varieties of seed ^{free of cost} and provision of facilities for testing to groups of small/marginal farmers and assistance to such farmers for establishing such farms.
 - (ix) Minor irrigation schemes including boring of tube wells and instal-
lation of pumpsets for the benefit of groups of small/marginal farmers.
 - (x) And such other projects and programmes of rural development.

3. PROPERTY VESTED IN THE TRUSTEES :

The founder doth hereby transfer a sum of Rs.1,001/- (Rupees one thousand and one only) in favour of the Trustees, thereof. The Trustees shall hold the said Trust for the use and the benefit of the trust. The trustees shall out of the income realised from the properties endowed and such other endowments or donations which they

may get, pay all taxes and all expenditure connected with the Trust.

4. BOARD OF TRUSTEES :

- a. The Board of Trustees will ordinarily consist of not less than three and not more than nine members.
- b. Mrs. Jeeva Varghese shall be the Managing Trustee and she shall hold office for life.
- c. The Trustees co-opted shall hold office only for two years and are liable for retirement. The Trustees whose term of office expires after the period of two years, are eligible to be co-opted as Trustees again by the Managing Trustee.
- d. A trustee may if he/she so desires resign his trusteeship even before the expiry of the term of his Trusteeship.

The present incumbents being:-

1. Mrs. Jeeva Varghese
2. Mr. Dakshinamurthy Ebenezer
3. Mr. Henry Williams.

MANAGING TRUSTEE : (Duties and powers)

- a. Mrs. Jeeva Varghese shall be the managing trustee for life.
- b. She shall be the chief functionary of the organisation and she shall be the officer to sue or to be sued on behalf of the Trust.
- c. She shall have the power to appoint all the necessary staff for the management of the programmes of the trust and to fix their remuneration and service conditions, subject to service rules prescribed by the Trustees.
- d. She shall have power to enforce, resist, allow, remit, set-off or compromise/ or to refer to Arbitration of any claim by or against the Trust.
- e. To institute and carry on or discontinue and to defend legal proceedings in relation to the trust and for the trust and for the said purpose or purposes to sign, execute, verify and file any plaint, written statement, application, claim or objection as may be necessary.
- f. To appoint advocates, pleaders, or Attorneys for any or all of the purposes stated in the clause (g) and (h) thereof.
- g. To demand, receive, take, transfer of and recover or allow on-account of any money or moneys or property belonging to the trust and to give effective receipts and releases and in a proper case indemnities for or in respect of any money or property so received or allowed in account by or transferred or delivered to

- h. To draw, accept, endorse, give, make or negotiate cheques, bills, hundis notes, guarantee or other security whether of the State or Central Government for any of the purposes aforesaid.
- i. To execute, do or conduct in or cause to be executed and do all such deeds, instruments and things in relation to the trust and for the said purposes to sign, execute, endorse, or transfer any deed or instrument or thing and to present the same for registration before any Registering authorities.

5. THE INCOME AND FUNDS OF THE TRUST:

The income and funds of the Trust will be solely utilised towards the objects and no portion of it will be utilised for payments to trustees by way of profit, interest, dividends or otherwise.

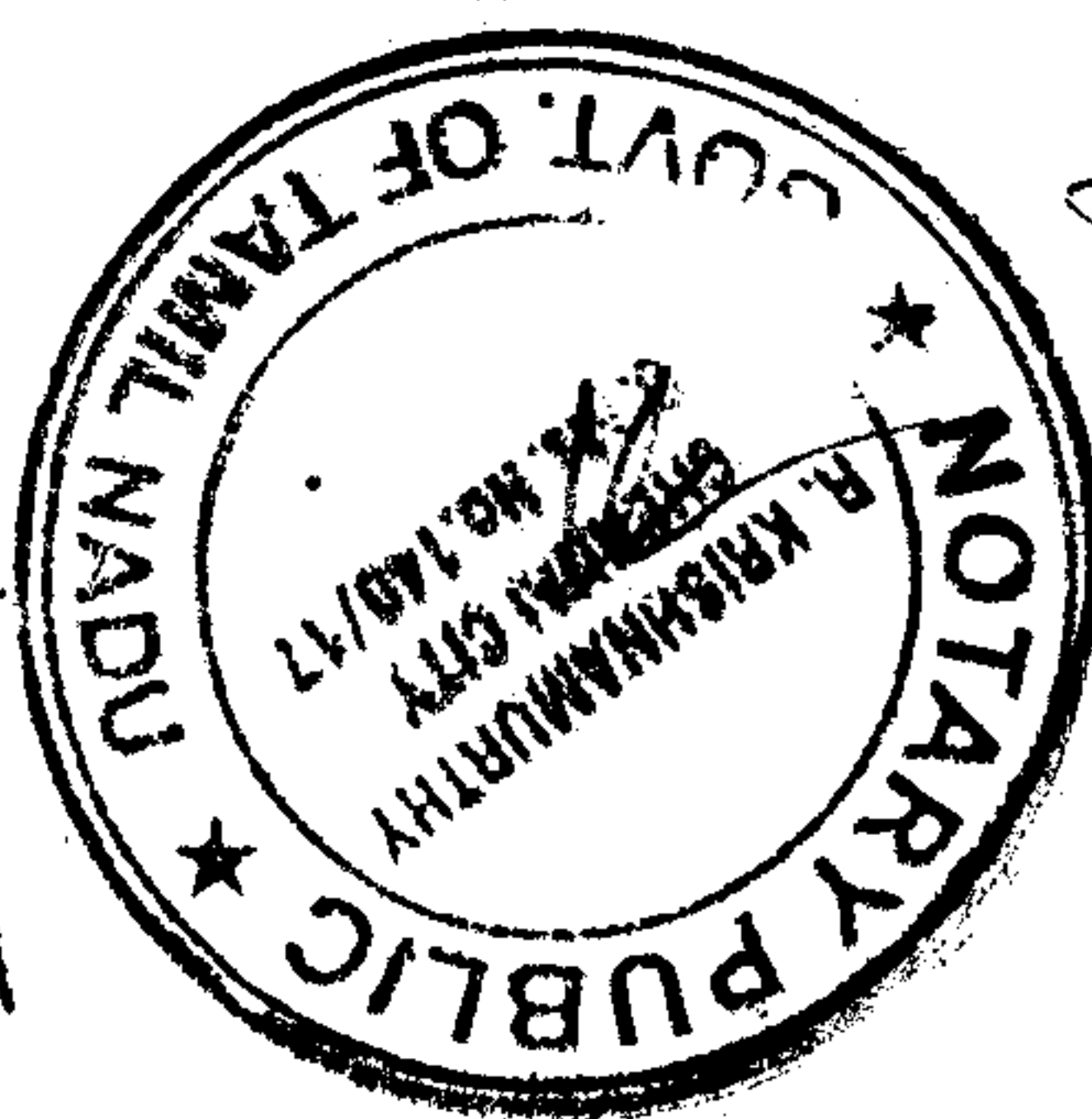
6. MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES :

In the absence of the Managing Trustee at any meeting, the Trustees present may elect one among themselves as chairman of the meeting.

7a. POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES :

- a. The trust may receive donations and/ or properties when received shall be at the absolute disposal of the trust.
- b. The Trustees shall invest the properties and moneys of the trust in such manner as prescribed under Sec.11 of the Income-Tax Act, 1961 and other statutory laws.
- c. The Board of Trustees shall meet as often as necessary and their proceedings shall be recorded regularly in the minutes Book to be retained for the purpose.
- d. The Trustees may open and operate current or deposit or other accounts with any scheduled Bank or Banks and by resolution authorise any two of the Trustees jointly to operate on such accounts.
- e. The Board may by resolution extend the activities of the trust or undertake any activity in furtherance of the main object of the Trust.
- f. Proper books of accounts shall be maintained of the Trust and shall be audited by a Chartered Accountant.
- g. To do such other lawful things as are incidental in carrying out the administration and management of the Trust.
- h. The Trustees shall maintain the Minutes Book in which the proceedings of all meetings of the Trustees shall be recorded by the Trustees and the same shall be signed by the Chairman of the Meeting.
- i. The Trustees may frame rules and regulations as to appoint sub

committees, mode of conducting any other matters connected with the administration of the Trust and its management.

7b. ADVISORY BODY :

The Trustees may maintain a set of advisors for the purpose of utilising their services in furtherance of the objects of the trust.

8. CUSTODY OF DOCUMENTS :

The Managing Trustee or his nominee or any other Trustee if so authorised by the Board of Trustees shall have the custody of all documents, deeds of title relating to the Trust and shall be responsible for the preservation of the same.

9. IRREVOCABILITY :

It is declared that the Trust is irrevocable. If the Trust fails for any reason, in the opinion of the Trustees the net assets of the trust both movable and immovable shall be handed over to any other Trust having the same objects as decided by the majority of the Trustees.

10. ALTERATION AND AMENDMENTS :

Any alteration, addition or deletion to this document shall be made with the approval of at least 2/3 of the board of trustees then holding the position and also subject to the approval of the Commissioner of Income-tax.

ANNUAL SOCIAL & CHARITABLE ACTIVITIES REPORT (2022–2023)

Introduction

Tambaram Community Social Centre continued its commitment to serving children, poor families, widows, marginalized communities and people in need during the year 2022–2023.

The Centre's activities focused particularly on **education, food and nutrition, livelihood development, healthcare, counseling and assistance to vulnerable families.**

Educational Support for Children

The Centre conducted free coaching classes for children from Monday to Friday throughout the year, providing regular academic support and encouragement in their studies. As part of this initiative, the Centre continued to provide free daily coaching to 60 children from the Gypsy community, ensuring that children from this marginalized group had consistent access to educational support. Through this sustained effort, the programme facilitated regular learning and contributed to the educational development of children from underserved backgrounds.

Food Support for Leprosy-Affected Families

The Centre provided one meal every day to 60 leprosy-affected families throughout the year. This regular food programme sought to support families facing social and economic difficulties resulting from leprosy-related stigma and marginalization, ensuring they received consistent nutritional assistance.

Monthly Support for AIDS-Affected Families

The Centre provided free rice and groceries every month to 30 AIDS-affected families throughout the year. This programme ensured regular food assistance to these vulnerable families, helping to ease the economic burden associated with their circumstances and supporting their basic nutritional needs.

Sunday Free Food Programme

Every Sunday, the Centre provided free food to people living on the streets and other needy persons throughout the year. This weekly programme was intended to address the immediate nutritional needs of vulnerable individuals, while demonstrating care and concern for those living without adequate food and support.

Monthly Support for Widows and Poor Families

Every month, the Centre distributed rice and essential groceries to widows and poor families. This regular assistance helped vulnerable households meet their basic food requirements and provided a measure of stability to those facing economic hardship.

Free Balwadi Centre – Cuddalore

The Centre continued operating a free Balwadi centre for children from fishermen's families in Cuddalore. The centre provided early childhood care, learning opportunities, and a supportive environment for young children, laying a strong foundation for their overall development.

Free Eye Medical Camp

The Centre conducted its annual free eye medical camp for members of the community. The camp provided an opportunity for people to receive basic eye screening and medical guidance, helping identify vision-related issues and enabling timely access to appropriate care.

Free Tailoring Classes

Free tailoring classes were conducted periodically during the year. The programme provided practical vocational skills and encouraged participants, particularly economically disadvantaged persons, to develop opportunities for self-employment and livelihood.

Festival Charity Programme

During the festival, the Centre reached out to poor and downtrodden people, providing them with food and gifts. The programme enabled the Centre to share joy and extend practical assistance to vulnerable members of the community during the festive season.

Conclusion

The year 2022–2023 was marked by continued service to vulnerable communities. Through education, food assistance, healthcare, vocational training and counseling, Tambaram Community Social Centre sought to improve the well-being and dignity of the people it served.

ANNUAL SOCIAL & CHARITABLE ACTIVITIES REPORT

(2023–2024)

INTRODUCTION

During 2023–2024, Tambaram Community Social Centre continued its ongoing social and charitable programmes for vulnerable and marginalized communities. The Centre maintained its focus on education, food security, healthcare, vocational skills, child development, counselling, and welfare assistance. These programmes provided continuing support to children, people living on the streets, leprosy-affected families, widows, poor families, AIDS-affected families, and fishermen's families.

FREE COACHING FOR CHILDREN

The Centre conducted free coaching classes for children from Monday to Friday throughout the year, providing regular academic support and encouragement in their studies. 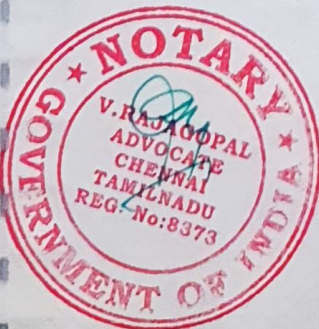

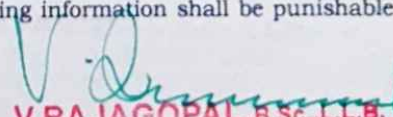

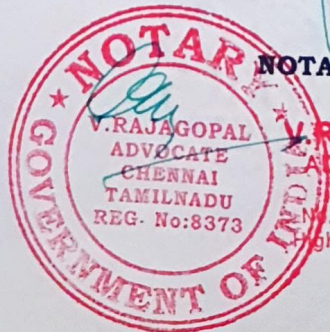
